## **ENCOURAGE LEARNING IN YOUR KIDS**

ny hard-working entrepreneur will agree that the road to success is paved by failure. But for many students, one success after another paves a way as far from failure as possible. So how do we teach students that learning often involves failing?

We train them to be well-rounded, problem solvers. We value learning over accomplishment. We nurture creativity and critical thinking. When children expect and accept failure as part of the growth process, their aptitude for knowledge increases.

Consider these questions to encourage learning in your kids.

#### WHAT MAKES YOU PROUD?

Do you show off report cards and A+ tests on the refrigerator? Instead of that — or in addition to it — display problems your students are proud of solving. Or even better, problems they are still trying to solve.

If you have a small white board, put a new long division problem up every day, and solve it together during breakfast. Or write a new daily vocab word for their foreign language.

By highlighting the process of learning, memorizing, or working through problems, you take the focus off of the final product.





#### WHAT DO YOU REWARD?

Many parents pay a flat fee for every A on a report card. Or they take a family trip to the ice cream shop after a dance recital. There's nothing wrong with this. But consider finding ways to praise good work along the way.

For example, get that ice cream after a heartbreaking loss in a soccer game. Not as a consolation, but because your kid shook hands with his opponents, cheered on his teammates, and kept a positive attitude.

Or post a video on social media — not of a polished, practiced piano performance, but once your child finally masters the tough section that has intimidated her in Beethoven's *Sonatina in G*.

Words of affirmation also go a long way. Think about specific strengths and areas of improvement for your kids.

"I noticed you got a big snack after school today instead of heading straight for the TV. That's such a great choice to set you up for a productive homework session so you can play before dinner!" Or, "It seems like that Lego set was really frustrating you. I'm proud of you for not smashing what you've already built and stepping away. How about we go back to it together and see if we can figure it out?"

#### WHERE CAN YOU GROW AS WELL?

As we raise lifelong learners, we embrace learning for ourselves. We know that education doesn't stop once we graduate, but sometimes we forget to be intentional about it. After all, avoiding failure plagues adults as well as children.

Let your children watch you try and fail. Show them you are below average at something. Be free to laugh at yourself and make light of new situations. Model discipline and consistency in becoming a better version of yourself. Here are some ideas:

- Pick up a new physical activity like running or weight lifting, and then show up regularly to practice.
- Try to learn a new language or join them in what language they are learning.
- Research the properties of turmeric that might help ADHD, and then experiment with recipes in the kitchen.
- Do you have a presentation at work coming up? Practice in front of your kids, and let them evaluate you.
- Next time you lose your temper, double book the calendar, or forget a promise you made, apologize quickly and explain what you're going to do differently next time. Ask them to help keep you accountable for changing.

Encouraging learning boils down to highlighting the process and not necessarily the destination.



## A tribute to Queen Elizabeth II

s many of you know, Queen Elizabeth II passed away on Thursday, Sept. 8. Although she lived to age 96, her passing was still a shock, and I didn't expect how deeply I would feel her loss. It felt as if I had lost my mother or grandmother.

While she is mourned all around the world, many Americans don't understand why the Queen meant so much to our country.

Growing up in England, Queen Elizabeth II was the one constant in our lives and was always a part of my life. Prime ministers came and went (15 of them), and the country went through some of its toughest times, but it was the Queen who was always there, steadfast in her duties and showing strength and leadership.

Whenever she would give a speech or address, we would all watch intently and listen to every word. She was so eloquent and regal yet, at the same time, calming and reassuring. You felt she was talking directly to you, and you always knew everything she said was sincere and heartfelt. She was part of our family, and we were all part of hers.

Everyone wanted to celebrate special royal events, such as birthdays, anniversaries, jubilees, and weddings because we loved and admired the Queen. The pride and honor everyone felt toward her was beyond anything I can even explain.

One of the British traditions I loved growing up were the street parties that were held all over the country for these special celebrations. I vividly remember Queen Elizabeth II's 25th Jubilee when we had a big street party and everyone in the neighborhood came out to celebrate together. The streets were blocked off and tables and chairs were lined up and down the middle and adorned with decoration. Everyone brought

I jumped online, booked a ticket, and left that afternoon for London. I was not alone! Over 12 million Britains attended street parties in her Majesty's honor. To be there in person walking the streets with the thousands of others who were there to show their love and respect for the Queen was simply amazing. I will cherish the memories of those days forever.

The Queen taught us all perseverance; she was the mother and grandmother to a nation and an example to the world. She led with dignity and grace. Her unwavering dedication and loyalty to the service of her country and her people were inspiring. She was also a very kind person, and she believed human beings to be capable of *great acts* of *kindness* and lived her life showing others by example through her endless charitable works.

Queen Elizabeth II was an inspiration to us all and now we can all hold on to a little piece of her memory and through her legacy strive to make this world a better place. She shared her daily mantra with us all in her 2002 Christmas Address:

## **National Day of Service Has Local Impact**

¬or the neighborhoods surrounding Mountain View High School, commemorating 9/11 this year meant pitching in to make improvements at four local schools on the morning of Saturday, Sept. 10.

More than 400 volunteers gathered at Mountain View High School with chainsaws, hedge trimmers, rakes, leaf blowers, and at least one dump truck. They removed 900 feet of tangled vines and shrubbery intertwined in a chain link fence surrounding the school's baseball fields.

Volunteer Shandiin Begay reflected, "It was overwhelming to look at the daunting task, but it was so satisfying to see all the progress we made as a whole group. My thoughts turned to the feelings after 9/11 and I can only imagine how hard that was for the first responders and for those rescued. I felt tremendous gratitude for my life and the ability to serve in remembrance of the love and unity we felt during 9/11. We couldn't be in New York City, but we could serve a neighbor or a friend and hold our family tight."

A half mile away at Hale Elementary, volunteers touched up the paint on a U.S. map on the playground, repainted lines around the exit doors, painted colorful stools for the school's STEAM lab, and pulled a summer's worth of weeds from the garden boxes.

Just south at Field Elementary, families of all ages constructed two garden boxes, tilled the soil, power washed garbage cans, painted a bathroom, cleaned and organized a rock garden, and picked up trash around the campus.

And at the neighboring Poston Junior High, volunteers power washed and sanitized picnic tables, and pulled out weeds throughout the school grounds. Principal Michael Rapier was impressed with the turn-out of volunteers and soon realized he could include more projects to keep everyone busy. Cafeteria tables and garbage cans were added to the service to be washed and sanitized.

Kyera Hansen, a 12-year-old student at Poston Junior High, cleaned tables and pulled weeds at her school. She







said she was grateful for the experience." I felt like I was a part of a team for good. We came together to support each other like they did when 9/11 happened 21 years ago. Made me think that we can accomplish anything when we help each other."

Izzi Beynon, a 15-year-old sophomore at Mountain View, started the morning by cleaning lunch tables at Poston and later was part of the crew pulling vines off the fence at Mountain View. She reported that, "It was hard work, but I'm really glad I got to go."

The projects were inspired by 911Day.org, a national nonprofit organization that, according to its website, seeks to "transform the anniversary of 9/11 into a national day of doing good and in the process, rekindle the spirit of unity that arose in America in the immediate aftermath of the Sept. 11, 2001, terrorist attacks."

As a full partner of the 911Day organization, JustServe.org coordinated hundreds of volunteer projects all over Arizona and the Southwest, including the projects that took place in the Mountain View neighborhood.

Mountain View High School Principal Mike Oliver thanked the volunteers for the more than 1,200 volunteer hours of service, saying, "We anticipated the project taking multiple days or even weeks, and this amazing group of dedicated community members knocked it out in just one day. This effort united our community during a season when our differences at times have unfortunately created a divide."

## Mesa Community College Launches **NEW ADVANCED IT PROGRAM** REGISTRATION IS OPEN FOR PREREQUISITE APPLECARE COURSE

he Maricopa IT Institute-East Valley (MITI-EV) launches a new IT certification program at Mesa Community College in Spring 2023. The program provides the knowledge to support, manage, and deploy Apple products in multiple industries. Registration is open for one of the AppleCare prerequisite courses.

The new professional IT training series will prepare technicians, administrators, and engineers to deploy, manage, repair and support the Apple ecosystem of products.

AppleCare iPhone Technician (ACiT) Certification (BPC260) meets online Monday and Wednesday evenings, Oct. 17 through Dec. 16. Registration for AppleCare Mac Technician Certification (BPC262) for the spring 2023 semester opens Oct. 10.

"By taking the prerequisite courses, students will be well on their way to gaining the knowledge and skills necessary to be the first to enter the new program in



spring 2023," explains Diane. Students enrolled during fall 2022 semester will have access to priority registration for spring courses, including BPC262. ■





Once students better understand their options, their high school counselors will assist them with the next steps in their post-secondary education quest.

#### **FASFA ASSISTANCE FOR COLLEGE**

Dr. Michael Garcia, director of the Opportunity & Achievement department, wants parents to know that there will be a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) booth, specifically to help students fill out their FASFA form.

The FASFA is the free application used by all schools in awarding federal student aid. Most students receive some type of financial aid, and it's highly recommended that students fill the form out even if they are unsure if they will qualify, so they are prepared when they start the application process.

"It's one of the most important steps students and families can take to pay for college," Dr. Garcia shares. "The earlier a student applies, the more sources of aid may be available."

Students must pre-register for the Greater Arizona College Fair. They can use a QR code or register via Snapchat. StriveScan will be able to scan the student's barcode at registration, making it easier and more efficient to share student contact information with exhibitors.




