## **EXERCISE IMPROVES QUALITY OF LIFE** FOLLOWING HEART FAILURE

**\** o, I have heart failure, doctor, and you recommend I should exercise. I am concerned exercise will worsen my heart failure.

Ryan, a 28-year-old IT executive and father of a 2-yearold son, posed this question to me several months ago during one of his follow-up visits in my clinic.

Ryan was an active and healthy young man 12 months earlier, running close to 50 miles a week when a simple viral infection of his sinuses and throat was complicated by the involvement of the heart, causing heart failure. Ryan was hospitalized, kept on life support with plans

for a heart transplant. Fortunately, he continued to improve. Heart transplant plans were cancelled, and he was discharged.

Over the next several months, we adjusted and readjusted his medications, outlined weight goals, arranged meal planning around his likes and dislikes of food, and, most importantly, dealt with his fears and apprehensions. Over the next few months, his ankle swelling, shortness of breath, nausea and palpitations stabilized and then resolved. Ryan obviously was improving on all fronts, including his energy level.

In contrast, Ryan's fears for the disease re-striking persisted. He absolutely refused cardiac rehabilitation, as he believed exertion would tire his heart and kill



him. Joan, his wife, shared with me that Ryan also was afraid to hold and play with his little son, Craig, as he felt it was too much exercise for his heart.

Antidepressants helped with his mood and depression, but initially, did little for his fears about exercise. Then he underwent a light low-level stress test in our office, which he passed with flying colors. Passing the stress test gave him the confidence to place his son in his lap and play with him. Ryan was overwhelmed with joy at this milestone. He called me to share his joy and disbelief that the exertion he underwent while playing with his son did not have any adverse effects.

I knew this was my opportunity, and I lost no time in reminding him again that exercise will slowly and surely have the same favorable effect on both his heart and his well-being. He agreed to an exercise prescription. Currently, he walks two miles on a daily basis, including weekends.


Exercise in itself does wonders for the mind and the body. Therefore, it should come as no surprise that a diseased heart also would experience wonders and benefits of exercise. We have enough data to confidently appreciate the benefits of exercise in heart failure. Exercise, including aerobic training, is not only desirable and feasible, but also quite safe in heart failure.

In heart failure, exercise decreases the risk and the rate of re-hospitalizations, while improving both the feeling of well-being and the quality of life. When Ryan underwent the stress test, in the monitored setting of our office, it gave him the boost to play with his son and the confidence thereafter to resume his








## Make sure your car really is in alignment

aving your vehicle aligned is a basic maintenance tool meant to keep the vehicle driving straight and achieve maximum life of the tires.

Did you know the most important alignment to perform on your vehicle is within the first 10,000 miles of ownership? The vehicle usually will come off the transport truck out of alignment, and during the first few thousand miles of driving, the suspension will start settling into place. Even after the initial break-in process, the suspension will continue to change due to wear and contact with curbs or other imperfections in the road.

It is recommended to have your vehicle aligned once a year, every 12,000 miles, or after new tires are installed. This will ensure proper wear patterns and longevity of the tires.

When deciding to have your vehicle aligned, it is very important to choose a repair shop capable of doing the alignment correctly. Unfortunately, there are plenty of places that will perform your alignment per basic specifications only. When this occurs, you still may have a tire wear issue. This is because the specification is a range and not an exact measurement.

The second concern is some vehicles do not have enough adjustability built into them in order to obtain





proper alignment. So, some service shops adjust what they can and do not give an option to correct the problems. So, in the end, you leave with a vehicle still out of alignment and wearing your tires unevenly.

There are three settings to a proper alignment—toe, which is how your tires are pointing forward; camber, which is how your tires are leaning; and caster, which is where the wheels are set in accordance to the center of the vehicle. Although, it is true, most alignments will require only a toe adjustment. This is also the only adjustment a lot of shops make. Camber is the next most important adjustment because it will cause uneven tire wear if not correct. Caster will affect only how the vehicle drives in a straight line.

Front-wheel-drive vehicles have specifications for both the front and rear axles. Sometimes, the adjustments cannot be made unless certain parts are changed on the vehicle first. Your alignment professional should inform you if there are repairs needed before a proper alignment can be performed.





Most people associate a' la mode with pie or cake served with ice cream on top or on the side. All of the incredible desserts created daily by Bistro Executive Chef Stephanie Petersen are served a' la mode, with premium vanilla ice cream or a dollop of

Choose from a different homemade tart, cake or pastry, or a homemade pie, or the everyday favorite, salted caramel butter bars—a creamy, lightly salted caramel filling in a shortbread crust. Can't decide? Order the pastry platter of all three for only \$13. Since the Bistro opens at 10:30 a.m., it's the perfect place for a morning cup of French Roast coffee with your pastries.

For lunch, Bistro offers diners four unique sandwiches and delicious luncheon salads, the fall favorite, pot pies, and occasional chef's specials, all with a choice of sides. Prices are reasonable, from \$4 to \$9. Beer, wine and mimosas also are available.

Having never tried the Bistro, which opened about a year ago inside the Stonebridge Manor mansion, my husband and I decided to go there for our lunch-date day. Everything sounded so delicious, we couldn't decide. So, we ordered the Tour de France, a half of each of the four sandwiches on fresh-baked artisan breads with two full side dishes for \$15.

The Grownup Grilled Cheese of the Day was filled with marinated pizza vegetables, asiago and pesto; sweet-hot sliced citrus-glazed turkey was spiced with cranberry balsamic; a buttery croissant nestled a chipotle ranch chicken salad; and the caprese chicken had a delicious pesto and balsamic glaze.

The Bistro is known for its unending varieties of mac and cheese, so we ordered the Cream Cheese Enchilada Mac and Grandma's Loaded Potato Salad (one





of the Bistro's summertime favorites) for our side dishes. Other sides include house-made potato chips, sweet-hot coleslaw, seasonal fruit cup, house salad or soup d'jour.

Choosing dessert was impossible, so the chef presented us the pastry platter. My husband loved Fall in a Bite carrot cake caramel pudding, made from the chef's' grandma's recipe. There was also an amaretto cherry pie a' la mode, a cayenne-spiced, brownie-bottom, decadent chocolate truffle cheesecake, and the caramel butter bars, a' la mode, of course.

"The Bistro is presently open from 10:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., for all-occasion lunches and even take-out," said Lindsay Hoff, lead server. "We also schedule private parties, such as rehearsal dinners or anniversary events, here at other times of the day and evening, serving the



same fantastic Bistro food," she continued. "We can accommodate up to 50 guests at \$15 to \$22 per person, plus tax and gratuity. Menu includes a choice of salad, entrée and dessert."

The Bistro also is a great place for a small corporate holiday lunch, dinner or event.

For larger gatherings, Stonebridge Manor offers full-service event planning in a more formal setting. "Call us with your plans, and we can arrange the details," Lindsay said. ■

## Be cautious of companies offering QUICK PURCHASE OF YOUR HOME

reveral new companies recently have come into the Phoenix Metro marketplace offering to purchase homes directly from homeowners for cash.

These are not the first companies to try their luck in the Valley. Investors have been drawn to the Phoenix market for decades.

Each time a new company arrives, there is a new twist, but mostly they offer a hassle free experience and quick closings.

Companies offering to quickly purchase your home are not in the business to do you a favor. They are in the business to make money and pay for radio ads. Their greatest advantage is you don't know all of the ins and outs of real estate.

Here are some reasons to be cautious:

- 1. Unless you already have your home listed, you, as the seller, do not have any representation. The companies buying your property are fully aware you are unrepresented, and are ready to take advantage of that fact.
- 2. Not all investors submit lowball offers. Instead, some companies offer something that sounds reasonable according to Zillow. If you have read our columns in the past, you know Zillow values usually are inaccurate. Investors seek out homes that already have a low Zillow value for the marketplace, fully knowing the Internet is the place where homeowners look to get information.
- 3. Some companies pay cash, but then ask for closing costs. It is highly unusual to ask for closing costs in a cash transaction. Closing costs are used to assist financed buyers and usually are a point of negotiation. This is the company's way of using psychology to actually come in with a lower offer without you really realizing it. Other companies come in with a reasonable offer, and then charge a series of fees. In both situations, your bottom line net is much lower than it appears.
- 4. They usually close quickly, but don't always conduct their inspections until the last minute. Some

- companies ask for a huge dollar credit for repairs (in some cases we have heard more than \$20,000). If you don't agree to pay for the repairs, they cancel the transaction. A few days before closing, most sellers have already arranged to move, so they pay the repair costs believing they have no other options.
- 5. Many bulk investors just have one agent handling all of their transactions. It is very difficult to get in touch with anyone at the company, and there are frequent errors along the way, not usually in the buyer's favor.

Being represented when you buy or sell a home means you have an advocate on your side. Professional Realtors know how to not only get a house under contract, but they can negotiate it all the way through to closing. It seems like it should all be simple, but it rarely is. Think of it this way. If you were involved in a lawsuit, you would hire the best lawyer to represent you. You wouldn't try your luck being your own attorney. Why risk trying to sell what is most likely your largest investment by yourself? It only will end well for the other side. ■

# MESA DOCTOR OFFERS SIMPLER Alternative to Allergy Shots

**▼** ot allergies or asthma? No time for allergy I shots at the doctor's office? According to Dr. Stuart Agren, MD, of Family Allergy Clinic, there is a better way with under-the-tongue allergy drops you can take at home.



Like allergy shots, drops are a form of immu-

notherapy—the only treatment shown to change the underlying allergy instead of just its symptoms. The drops are dispensed daily under the tongue where they absorb into the bloodstream through specialized mouth cells.

Dr. Agren began prescribing the drops at his Mesabased clinic when he found patients were struggling to be consistent with allergy shots. "It was difficult for patients to make time to come to the office twice a week for shots,"

Because allergy drops do not carry the same risk for anaphylactic reaction that shots do, they can be taken at home instead of under direct medical supervision. They

also have been shown to be safe for young children as opposed to shots, which aren't generally recommended for kids below age 8.

"While many patients suffer through allergy season with an arsenal of pills, nasal sprays and inhalers, allergy drops are often a wiser choice," Dr. Agren said. "Medications have side effects, and they may only be partially effective," he added. "But most of all, they don't treat the root of the problem. They're a band aid fix."

In contrast, allergy drops desensitize the body to allergens in the environment, so it will stop having allergic reactions in the first place.

The drops are made up of natural extracts. Therefore, they are easier on the body than synthetic medications. And unlike allergy shots, drops have been shown to safely reduce food allergies, as well as pollen allergies. Dr. Agren can treat for nearly 60 food allergens, including eggs, milk

Dr. Agren has safely treated more than 15,000 patients using allergy drops. "Allergies can wreak havoc on health, causing hay fever, asthma, eczema, hives, chronic ear infections, sinusitis, headache and fatigue," he said.

According to the doctor, patients may be candidates for allergy drops if:

- Their allergies last more than a few months each year.
- Their symptoms are severe enough to significantly diminish quality of life.

Dr. Agren believes drops are the wave of the future for allergy treatment. "In recent years, I have seen the medical dialogue shift toward sublingual drops," he said. "Allergies are getting worse, and lives are getting busier. People want a simple, effective solution."■



## Control your emotions IN VOLATILE MARKETS

**对** he stock market has moved up fairly steadily for the past few years, with no major corrections, but so far this year, we've already seen periods of volatility—enough to make some investors jittery.

Nervous investors may be more prone to make decisions

based on short-term market movements. So, how can you

First of all, when evaluating your investment decisions, stay focused on those factors that have historically driven stock prices. The U.S. economy is growing at a reasonably good pace, and corporate earnings remain fairly strong. Plus, stocks may not be as undervalued as they were a few years ago—as measured by the price-to-earnings ratio—but they still aren't overly expensive either.

Things can change, of course, but when market volatility seems to be primarily caused by short-term events, such as plunging oil prices, it's important to look beyond the headlines to these less glamorous, but probably more important, fundamentals of good investing. By doing so, you can help avoid making fear-driven investment choices.

What else can you do to help ensure you don't let feelings of anxiety influence your investment moves? For one thing, evaluate your investment mix. If you own too many stocks and stock-based vehicles, you could take a big hit if stock prices fall sharply during periods of volatility. Historically, however, bond prices typically have increased when stock prices fell—although, of course, there are no

guarantees. So, if your portfolio consists of stocks and bonds, you are better positioned to weather the harshest effects of market turbulence.

To further prepare yourself for downturns, you also may want to diversify your fixed-income holdings to include investments, such as U.S. Treasury bills, certificates of deposit and municipal bonds. The percentages of each type of investment within your portfolio should be based on your goals, risk tolerance and time horizon.

Finally, you can help yourself maintain an even-keeled approach to investing by always looking for quality. Typically, higher quality investments fare better during market declines and recover more quickly when the markets rebound.

How can you judge whether a particular investment is of good quality? A long-term track record is useful to study. It's certainly true that, as you have no doubt heard, past performance is no guarantee of future results, but it is, nonetheless, valuable to know how a particular stock, for example, has performed in various economic environments. If it seems to have done well relative to others in its industry and over long periods of time, that may give you a good idea of its quality.

It's never easy to take all the emotions out of investing, especially during periods of market volatility. After all, you count on your investments to help provide you with the type of future you've envisioned. But by focusing on the fundamentals, putting together an appropriate investment mix and constantly looking for quality, you can help de-stress yourself—and, as the American poet, novelist and historian J.G. Holland once said, "Calmness is the cradle of power."




